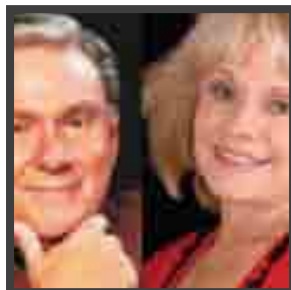
### Tim Conway and Friends - Oct 19th & 20th, Nov 10th & 11th
