The first official Branson show was the Baldknobbers. They started playing in downtown Branson and eventually moved to their present location on The Strip. The Presleys' Country Jubilee is on record as having the first theater in Branson. They've been entertaining since the early 60's.

And, Branson has been growing ever since. Many legendary entertainers such as Roy Clark, Andy Williams and more have entertained thousands at their theaters and continue to do so. Today, close to **seven million annual visitors** gather to hear great music from country to Rock n' Roll, see magic and laugh at comedy acts.

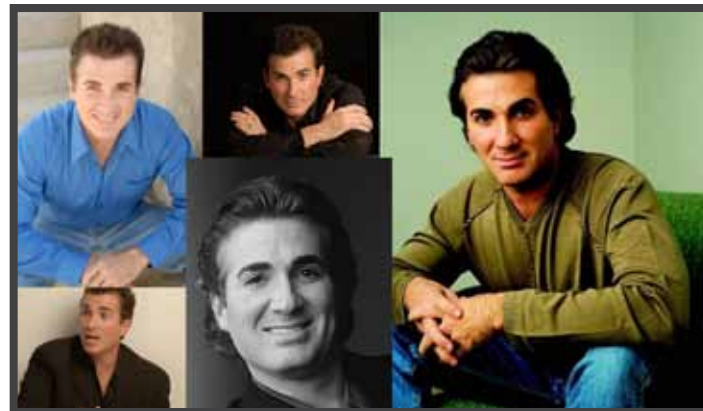
Garth Brooks A Tribute

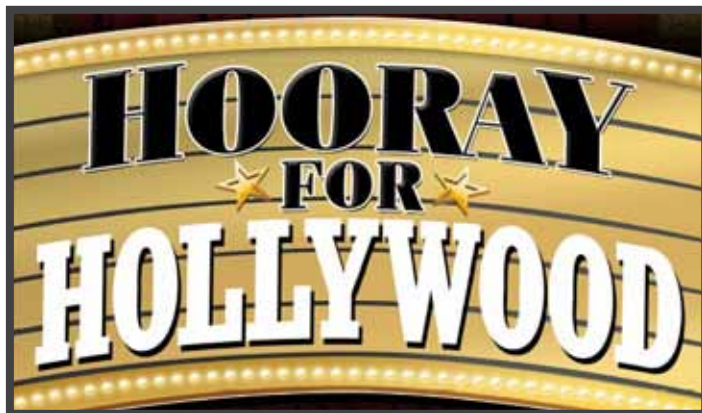
Hank Williams Revisited
